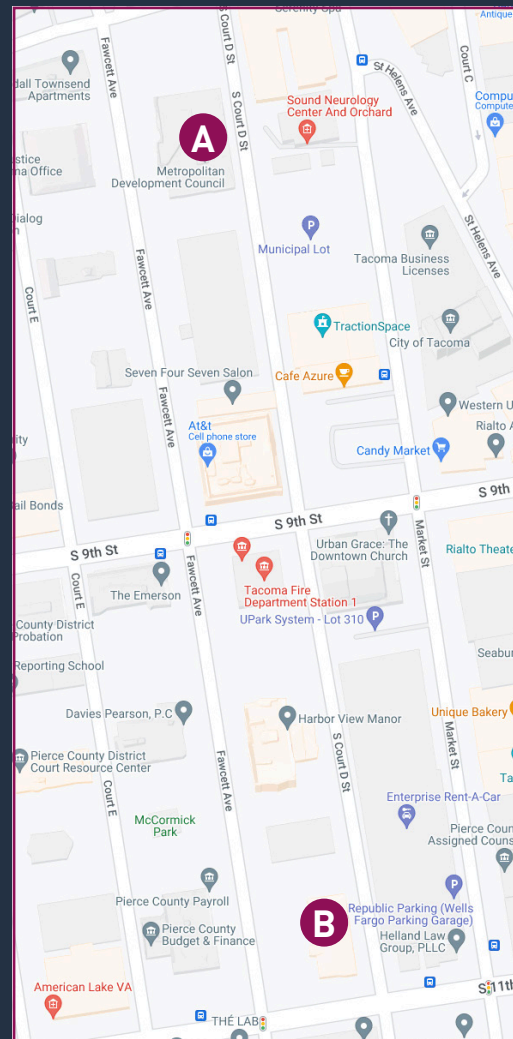

Education & Employment

Youth Education (253) 254-8329

Providing high schoolers with advising, mentoring, tutoring, field trips, workshops and college application support.

Educational Opportunity Center (253) 318-7582

Career assessment, advising, goal-planning, workshops and GED completion and college application support.



Community Services

Energy Assistance & Rental Assistance (253) 572-5557

Assistance with rent, energy bills, water bills or air conditioning for income-qualified households within Tacoma.

Weatherization (253) 339-0072

Services such as insulation and furnace repairs for income-qualified households within Tacoma.

Child and Adult Care Food Program (253) 284-7865

Cash reimbursement for food for licensed in-home daycares in Pierce, South King, Kitsap and Thurston counties.



Health

The Center for Behavioral Health (253) 593-2740

Substance use disorder services, mental health services and supported employment services for clients in our community.

Co-Occurring Treatment (253) 593-2740

Supporting people living in Tacoma who are experiencing mental health and substance use challenges in combination with a “Two Diagnoses, One Team” approach.

Mental Health Counseling/Outpatient Psychiatric (253) 593-2740

Behavioral health assessments and counseling for people ages 13 and older, including access to medication prescriber services.

Psychiatric Evaluation and Treatment Center (253) 207-4302

A 16-bed treatment center for psychiatric guests who need to be placed in involuntary treatment to stabilize their conditions.

Helping clients, including those who are currently experiencing homelessness, with access to housing and healthcare resources.

Withdrawal Management (253) 593-2413

Guests served 24/7 on a walk-in basis at 721 Fawcett Avenue or by calling to check bed availability. Assessments, withdrawal medication and care, and group and 1-on-1 sessions with a peer recovery coach.

Supported Employment (253) 290-2147

Employment services for people who are Medicaid-eligible and have physical, behavioral or long-term service needs that make it difficult for them to find or keep jobs. Includes job coaching and training, help with employer relations and assistance with job placement.



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
